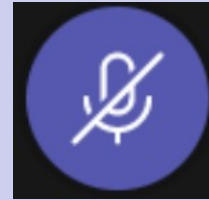




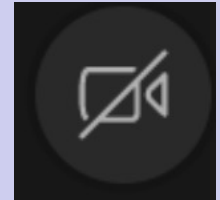
Welcome to Reception

Teams Guidance

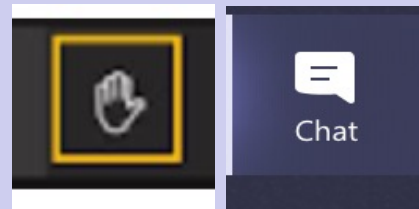
- Please ensure your microphone is muted so that background noise and inference is kept to a minimum.

Transition into Reception

- There is a virtual tour of the school on our school website. You will also find on the website a video of your child's class teacher saying hello and showing you around their new classroom. You will also find a fun fact file of your child's teacher and a blank copy for your child to complete.
- You will be offered either a home visit at your home or a 1:1 meeting at school. This will depend on government guidelines at the time but the time and date of this meeting will stay the same.
- Children will be having a staggered start to help with their transition. Children will have different start dates.

The Reception Day

- The school gates will open at 8.40 am. Reception playground will be opened at 8:50am. Children say goodbye to their parents/carers at the Reception gate.
- The school day starts at 9:00am and children need to be in class at this time. Registers are marked by 9:05am so to avoid a 'late mark' please ensure you are here by 9:00 am at the latest!
- Attendance: It is very important that you child attends school every day!



The Reception Day

- Lunch time is at 11:30-12:30.
- Lunch menus are available on our school website and every child in Reception is entitled to a free school dinner.
- Please inform your child's teacher if there are any dietary requirements.
- The teacher will dismiss the children at 3.30 pm.
- Parents meet children outside the classroom door.
- Your child is not allowed to go unless you or the designated adult is there. Please inform us of any change in your routine, giving the name of any other adults permitted to collect your child either by telephoning the school office or by telling a teacher when you drop your child off in the morning.

School Uniform

- Please note: school uniform is compulsory and this can be purchased online at www.brigadeuniformdirect.uk.com.
- Please **label** all school clothing including coats. School clothes and shoes should be practical which the children should be able to manage themselves. We ask that jewellery is not worn to school.
- Wingfield's book bags can be bought at the office.
- Children will be engaging in physical development activities throughout the week. Please can your child bring in a labelled PE kit on a Monday and then they can be taken home on a Friday.

Reading

- Every morning children's book bags should be put in the book box as your child comes in. Your child will have their book changed once a week and will bring home a phonics based book to read with you at home.
- Please write a comment in their home learning journal every day and once a week we will add a comment.

English

- Children in Reception engage in daily whole class sessions which include English and Phonics as well as their independent activities and focus group teaching.
- Every day we will teach whole class phonics and phonic groups. Phonics places the emphasis on the letter sounds not their names and using these sounds to segment and blend words, e.g. c-a-t = cat, p-i-n = pin.
- Also at the back of the home learning journal you will find key words that children need to be able to read and eventually write.

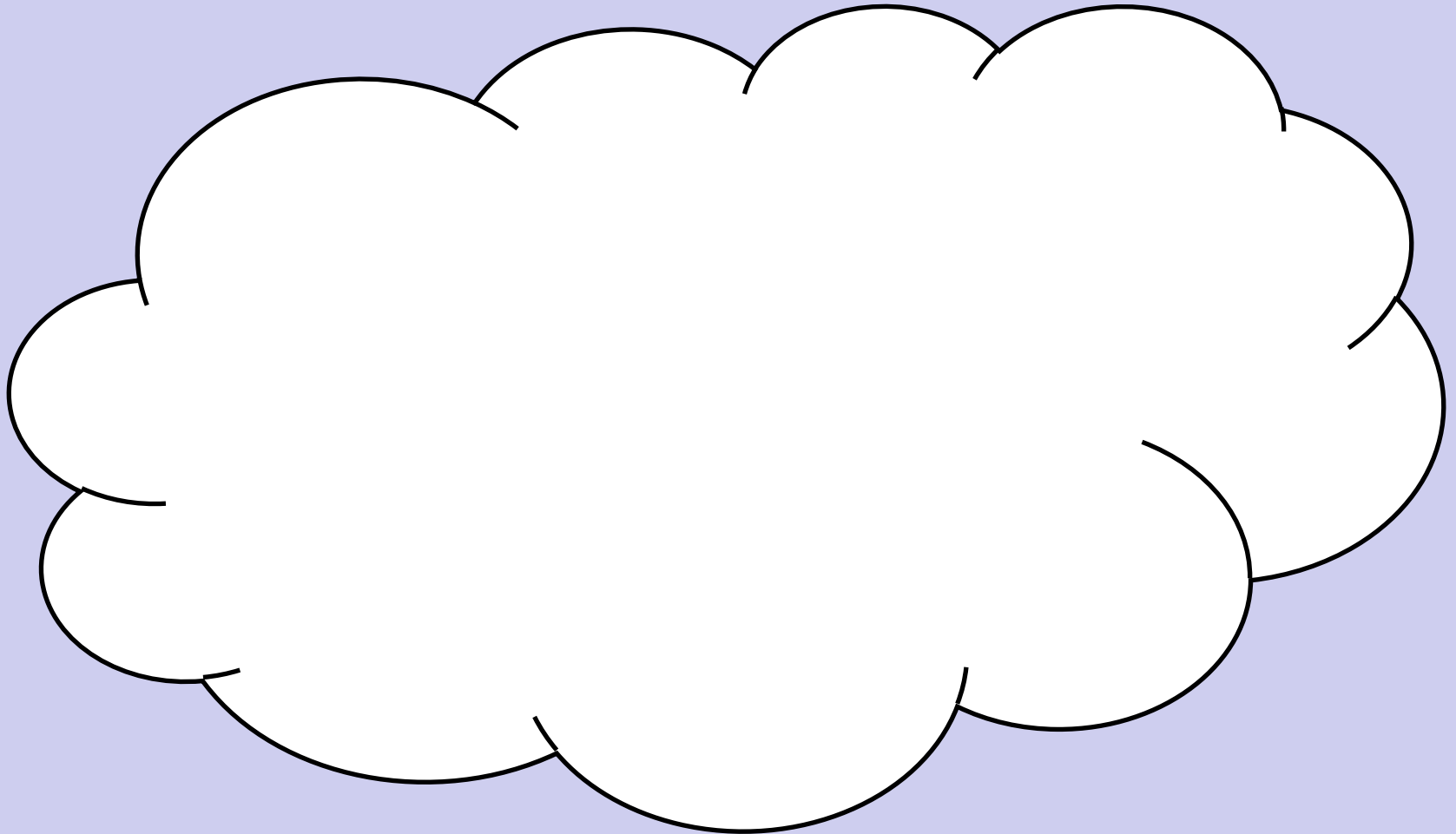
Maths

- Children in Reception engage in daily whole class Maths sessions as well as their independent activities and focus group teaching.
- In maths we focus on counting, number recognition, adding and taking away, shape, space and measures.
- By the end of Reception children will be working towards understanding the composition of numbers to 10, subitising to 5, recalling number bonds to 5 and 10 and double facts to 5.

Forest School

- Forest School will be starting in the Autumn term. Please can you make sure that your child has a pair of wellington boots when it is their Forest School day.
