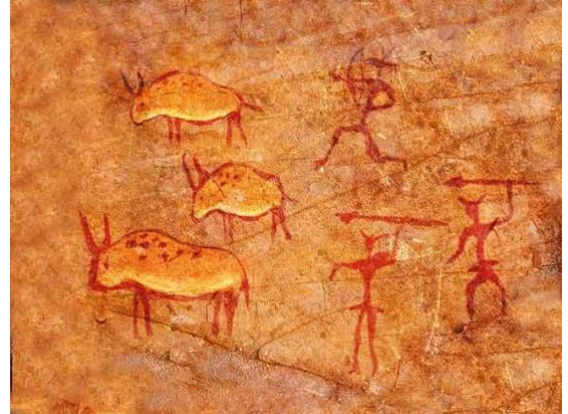
## Welcome!

Welcome back to another exciting term at Wingfield! It has been a great start to the term, with all children demonstrating a fantastic attitude and enthusiasm for their learning.

## Unit of Learning: The Stone Age

This term we will be learning about the **Stone Age!** We will be exploring how people lived in the Stone Age, how we have built life based on the past and how people used natural resources. The children will be producing several exciting learning outcomes based around the Stone Age, including a newspaper report, a video game and cave painting/chalk art!

## Maths

In Maths, we will be focussing on **multiplication** and **division** methods. We will be developing mental and written methods of multiplication and division, including **repeated addition** and using the **grid method**, as well as **repeated subtraction**. Towards the end of the term, we will begin to look at **measurement**, focussing on **length** and **perimeter**. We will begin looking at how to find the perimeter of given shapes, as well as using multiplication knowledge for **scaling**. The children will also be developing their knowledge of **times tables**, supported with their weekly times tables homework.

## Uniform

As the weather changes, we advise that you **label all items** of your child's school uniform, particularly their **jumpers/cardigans**. This will enable us to return missing items to the correct children. Please remember that children should be wearing a school jumper/cardigan that has the **school logo** on it. Children are **only** permitted to wear **black** school shoes or trainers; boots are not allowed. Please ensure your child takes their **earrings** out before school, as they are **not** permitted due to health and safety regulations.

## PE Lessons

From the beginning of the term, the children will have PE on the following day: **Monday AM** (both classes). Children should wear a plain white t-shirt and plain black or grey shorts or jogging bottoms with black plimsolls. Tracksuits and other clothing with logos are **not** permitted. **Please ensure that they are wearing their kit on their P.E day.** As some of their PE sessions are outside, we advise that you provide your child with both an **outdoor** and an **indoor** PE kit. If your child's PE day **changes**, the school office will notify you via. Parent Mail.

## Home Time

If your child is going home with somebody who does not normally pick them up (**including** a close relative or another parent), please notify your child's teacher **and** the school office **the day before**. If we are unaware of any change in pick-ups, your child will **not** be allowed to leave the school until we have contacted you for confirmation. To avoid delays, please let us know as soon as possible.

## Home Learning

Please continue to support your child with their reading. Your child should be reading **every evening** and recording this in their **home learning journal**. They should be bringing a reading book along with their home learning journal to school **every day**. Please also continue to support your child with their spellings and times tables in their weekly homework. Homework is posted on **Showbie** on **Friday** at **3:30pm** and expected to be completed before the **following Friday**. Your child can also access extra online learning on Prodigy Maths Game and TTRockstars.
