Welcome

Welcome back to another exciting term at Wingfield! We hope you have enjoyed your break and are looking forward to coming back to school on **March the 8th 2021**.

Unit of Learning: The Romans

This term, we will be learning about **The Romans!** We will be exploring what an Empire is, learning about the lives of Julius Caesar and Boudicca and thinking about how we have built modern life based on ideas from the past.

Our end goal for the end of the term is to create a non-fiction fact file about Caesar or Boudicca; the children will then have an opportunity to publish their fact file as creatively as they would like!



Home Learning

For the first 2 weeks of term, we will continue to deliver live sessions via **Showbie** - It would be amazing to see as many children attending the sessions as possible! Our live **registration** session will continue to begin at **9:30am** and our live **lesson** will begin at **10:15am**. We will try to stick to these times, however please check Showbie regularly in case of any timetable interference. Please revisit the Showbie behaviour for learning document with your child to remind them of expectations during the live sessions.

Showbie

We are setting **4** pieces of Showbie learning a day (English, maths, reading and unit of learning OR science) and would ask that your child attempts to access **as much of it as possible** to keep them learning from home and occupied. You can find this learning in the pink folder labelled **Home Learning January 2021**. We recommend that your child completes **English** and **Maths daily** and that they are regularly logging on and connecting with us on Showbie, as this will be good to encourage and motivate them. If you have any questions about the learning, you can message your child's teacher via the home learning folder. If your child is unable to log in to Showbie, please contact the **school office** so that they may retrieve your child's details.

Uniform

As the weather changes, we advise that you **label all items** of your child's school uniform, including their **jumpers** and **PE kits**. This will enable us to return missing items to the correct children. Please remember that children should be wearing a school jumper/cardigan that has the **school logo** on it. Children are **only** permitted to wear **black** school shoes or trainers; boots are not allowed. Please ensure your child takes their **earrings** out before school, as they are **not** permitted due to health and safety regulations.

PE Lessons

This term, the children will have PE on **Thursday mornings**. On P.E days, your child will be expected to wear their full P.E kit to school and will remain in their kit for the rest of the school day. Children should wear a plain white t-shirt and plain black shorts, leggings or jogging bottoms, with black plimsolls or trainers. Children can also wear a plain black crew neck sweater as part of an outdoor/winter P.E kit. **Hooded tracksuits and other clothing with logos are not permitted.**

Home Time

If your child is going home with somebody who does not normally pick them up (including another parent), please advise your child's teacher **and** the school office **the day before**. If we are unaware of any change in pick-ups, your child will **not** be allowed to leave the school until we have contacted you for confirmation. To avoid delays, please let us know as soon as possible.
